Instead, you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God (the heavenly Jerusalem), to myriads of angels in festive gathering, ²³ to the assembly of the firstborn whose names have been written in heaven, to God who is the Judge of all, to the spirits of righteous people made perfect, ²⁴ to Jesus (mediator of a new covenant), and to the sprinkled blood, which says better things than the blood of Abel.

You can only run when you are FREE from the Law! Running is not possible under the burden of the Law!

PAUL on the **Bondage to Law vs. Freedom by Grace through Faith** – a constant fight in his day and in ours.

- Romans 1-10; 1 Corinthians 8-10; Galatians 2-5;
- Hebrews 12

In the province of Galatia the "circumcision" crew was at it trying to add legal requirements to grace. So in Paul's letter to the Galatians he addresses the freedom we have in Christ versus the slavery of living under the Law. Over and over he emphasizes that grace and legalism are mutually exclusive – they cannot coexist.

In Galatians 4, Paul says

Galatians 4:30

... for the son of the slave will never be a coheir with the son of the free woman.

And in Galatians 5 he goes on to say:

Galatians 5:1, 7

¹ Christ has liberated us to be free. Stand firm then and don't submit again to a yoke of slavery. ...

⁷ You were running well. Who prevented you from obeying the truth?

You can't run, you can't carry out God's perfect purpose for you while carrying the weight of the Law. In Matthew 23:4 Jesus said that those whose religion is based in legalism

"... tie up heavy loads that are hard to carry and put them on people's shoulders, but they themselves aren't willing to lift a finger to move them."

WHY is Legalism such a problem? - Legalism brings the burden of guilt with no solution.

Run from sexual immorality! ...

Hebrews 12:4-7

⁴ In **struggling against sin**, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood.

My son, do not take the Lord's discipline lightly or faint when you are reproved by Him, 6 for the Lord disciplines the one He loves and punishes every son He receives. [Proverbs 3:11-12]

He's alluding to both:

- Jesus struggling against the temptation in the garden to abandon the call of God on his life – to step out of the Father's will; and
- 2. Christ's sacrifice on the cross to pay the debt we owe because of our sin.

Have we ever fought *against* temptation in our lives so much that we worked up even a minor sweat, much less sweating drops of blood?

DISTRACTIONS

 – Anything that keeps you from focusing on God's best for your life

1 Timothy 6:9-11a



⁷ Endure suffering as discipline: God is dealing with you as sons. For what son is there that a father does not discipline?

⁹ But those who want to be rich fall into temptation, a trap, and many foolish and harmful desires, which plunge people into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, and by craving it, some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pains. But you, man of God, **run** from these things...
