


Message 1: The Source of Abundance – The Great GOD Almighty

Flying is the evidence of faith, the breeding ground of faith, the fertile soil of faith, the nutrition for faith, and the test of faith.






Message 4: Run, Man, Run – Straining Toward the Goal

Message 6: Renewed!

• Ephesians 6:10-20

"Those who trust in the Lord will renew their strength..."

In the previous five messages,

- we've talked about the source of strength—the Lord,
- we've talked about how we get connected to that source trust,
- and we've talked about what that strength enables us to do—soar, run, & walk.

We've talked about what God's amazing goals are for our lives, and if we had no other challenges we couldn't meet those goals in our own strength. But we *have* challenges and we *have* and adversary. So we desperately need a strength greater than our own.

But we've not talked about the "renewal" part and the nature of the strength with which we get renewed.

The soaring, running, and walking is what we do after we've "gained new strength" (NASB). This new strength is not our doing. We can't strengthen ourselves if we don't have strength to begin with. The strength has to come from some outside source. And this passage says that source is the Lord. Scientists have long searched for a "perpetual motion" machine – one that, once started, would run indefinitely without an outward source of power. It has never been found.

They've searched for perfect efficiency machines – where every ounce of power went straight to performing the desired task with no loss of energy. That machine hasn't been found either. In order to get anything done, there has to be an outside power source.

MONDAYS

Ok, Mondays are hard days for me. I'm usually wiped out after Sunday. Virtually every pastor I know and most worship pastors take a nap Sunday afternoon. Books and seminars about staff leadership acknowledge the drain of Sundays on staff and recommend against scheduling anything major on a Monday – no staff meetings, no major new decisions. Many pastors and staff members quit the ministry every Monday morning. Thank God most of them sign back up on Tuesday.

If you are going to live abundantly – if you are going to have faith to soar, endurance to run, and strength to keep on walking, you are going to need an external source of power.



¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. ¹⁹ Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰ for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.
